SELECTED ACHIEVEMENTS

As Project Manager, led 24/7 Quality Control Crisis Operation to successful and early completion and to customer, DOT and GAO satisfaction. **Result:** Successful turnaround and preservation of company’s license to operate, which was under threat of revoke and closure by the oversight agencies.

Established and implemented program, **trained** personnel, and **supervised** new centralized quality center to avoid deficiencies that caused the crisis situation discussed above. **Resulted** in significant improvement in operations, agency interface and cost savings from previous methods.

Developed major company support system re-organization, tailored after the above program, facilitating closure of an office of 500 plus personnel and opening of a much smaller office. This was requested by senior company management and **resulted** in savings of approx. 380 personnel salaries and expenses.

Performed key project management roles for owners, resident in EPC contractor offices with international responsibilities, during the development of Alaska’s Prudhoe Bay oil field. Specifically: a Enhanced Oil Recovery / Waterflood Project that **resulted** in 1.5 billion additional barrels of recovered oil; and, the largest gas plant in the world that **produces** 60 thousand barrels of natural gas liquids daily.

Negotiated multi-million dollar, multi-discipline design contract. **Analyzed** contractor personnel vs. contractor management problems and **convinced** our management that a contractor change was required. **Developed** request for proposal’s, **interviewed** bidders, **evaluated** bids, **recommended** successful contractor, and **administered** contract. **Result:** minimized contractor personnel turnover, and \$1 million cost savings over the three year contract.

Evolved consulting business into Alaska’s first scanning / document conversion company. Corporation President and CEO, responsible for profit & loss, governance, personnel, and overall operation. **Resulted** in profitable venture and successful project for BP.
